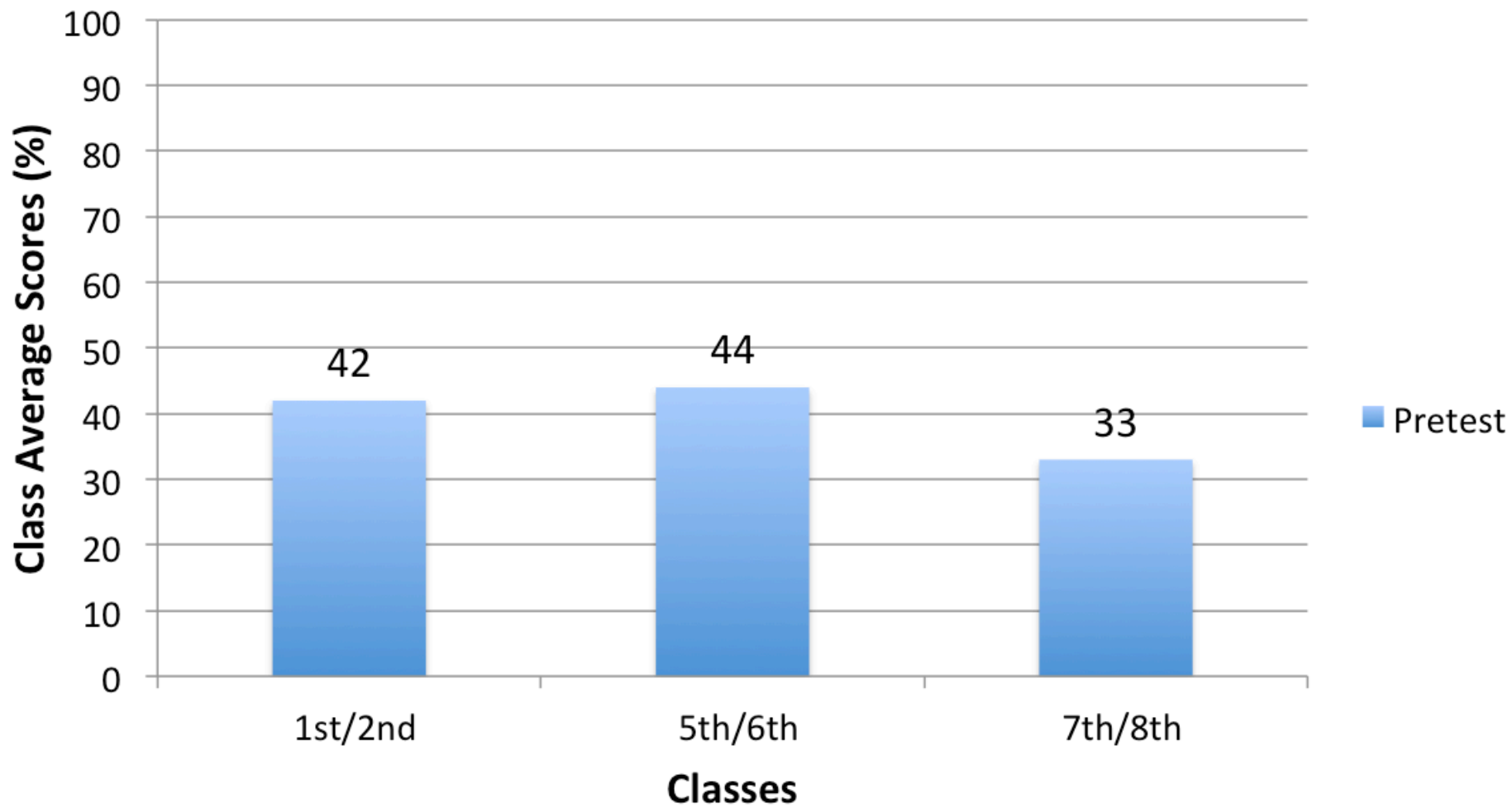

What is the difference between an inactive and an active muscle?
